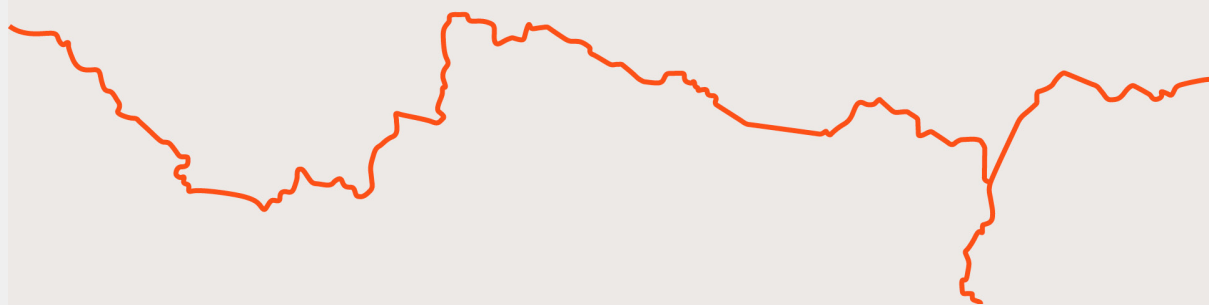




## **Sensing the Appearance of Historic Buildings - Materials and Craftsmanship**

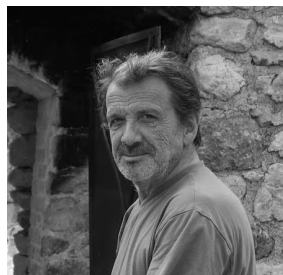

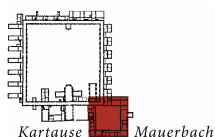
